- Based on the work requirements, decides as follows:





Chapter I Definitions and Scope of Application Article (1)

In applying the provisions of this resolution, the following phrases and words shall have the below meanings:

Work	Each innovative composition in the field of literature, science, or arts whatever its type or method of expression, importance, and purpose might be. Each visual, audio material, or both, is recorded on any of the technical methods, whatever their type might be, such as: tapes, compact disks, DVDs, or others.





Article (2) Scope of Application

The provisions of this resolution are applicable to the content of publications and artistic works including (cinema movies, video films, electronic games and video games, picture books and printed novels used on e-network) that are negotiated in the UAE including free-media zones.

Article (3)

- This resolution represents the general framework of age classification of artistic works that licensed media activities practitioners in the UAE should adhere to what is mentioned herein.
- This includes all forms of negotiation, public offering, distribution, selling, temporary rental, and retaining or offering for the purpose of sale, rental, or making such works accessible by any person.

Article (4) The basic principles of age classification system

This resolution aims at organizing the age classification of artistic works (cinema movies, video films, electronic games and video games, books and novels) according to the following basic principles:

- 1. Affirming respect for the general principles, frameworks, and criteria that govern media content in the UAE according to the laws and regulations.
- 2. Age classification and identification of the suitable age categories that are subject to the laws and regulations regarding their publication and negotiation.
- 3. Protection of children against exposure to the materials that hurt and annoy them and protecting them against what does not suit them.
- 4. Assisting the adults to correctly select the artistic works for themselves and for children they look after.
- 5. Providing enough information about artistic works to help individuals make a correct selection.





6. Providing balanced, accountable, and impartial age classification that respects individuals' privacy and protects the different classes of society against harmful and possible effects.

Article (5) Obligatory Nature of Classification

It is prohibited to print, negotiate, or enter any of the UAE's publications especially what is mentioned in article (2) of this resolution except after being classified according to this resolution's provisions and accredited media content criteria, and the Council shall have the right to stop or prohibit negotiating, printing, and entering any publication that is not committed to the classification criteria mentioned in this resolution and to sanction the violator.

Article (6)

When classifying the artistic works, (cinema movies, video films, electronic games and video games, books and novels) the following shall be observed:

- 1. Not to classify any work that the laws and regulations prohibit being negotiated.
- 2. Adherence to the criteria of media content.
- 3. Respect freedom of opinion and expression.
- 4. Children's rights shall be protected against ill-treatment, negligence, abuse, and vilification.
- 5. The freedom of feeling safe including protection against exposure to unwanted subjects that are considered to be abusive to the UAE and society and inconsistent with the norms and inherent morals, such as (homosexuality human trafficking cases discrimination and hatred).
- 6. Respect intellectual property rights.

Article (7) Classification Dismissal

Classification shall be dismissed in the cases wherein the work basis mainly contradicts with the criteria of media content issued by the Council.





Chapter II The age classification of cinema and video movies' content Article (8)

Age classification indicates that cinema and video movies' content are appropriate for a certain age group, and it is expressed by a number of symbols that indicates the suitable age group, as stated in the below table:

Chapter III Video game rating Article (9)

- The age classification of video games is the classification of the content of electronic games that are played on many devices such as (Nintendo) (PlayStation) (Xbox) or are played on personal computers, the Internet and mobile phones.
- Electronic games played, practiced or done on the Internet (on line games), which may include content that may be added by some players during the playing of the game (such as chat, instructions, maps, text,





images, videos, chats and other additions, the rating system places statements indicating this such as (The content of this electronic game may change while playing the game online) with the aim of alerting and educating parents that the content that may be added by some players while playing, practicing or completing the game on the Internet has not yet been classified by the rating system.

- Some electronic video games complete their stages via the Internet after paying the subscription fee, and their age classification may change.

Article (10)

The age classification indicates that the content of the game is suitable for a specific age group, and the following are the classifications and age groups that apply to video games, as follows:

The age classification indicates that the content of books and novels is appropriate for a specific age group. The following age classifications and categories apply to picture books and novels as follows:

General	• General content that presents knowledge in an interesting way that includes positive messages and behaviors that take into account the interaction between the image and the text and focus on explaining general concepts such as agreed upon general information.

Chapter V Classification Request Article (12)

The staff of the Council's Media Content Follow-up Department shall classify the publication in accordance with this resolution upon submitting the permission.

Article (13)

Any matter not provided for herein shall be subject to the provisions of Council's Chairman Resolution No. () of 2017 on the media content Executive Bylaw.

Chapter VI General Provisions Article (14)

- 1) The age classification of the publication must be adhered to as determined by the Council and in accordance with the permission issued under the provisions of this resolution.
- 2) No amendment may be made to the media content or the age classification approved and permitted by the Council in accordance with the provisions of this resolution. However, the Council may consider any amend thereto as a violation that requires taking the necessary legal measures in this regard.
- 3) The Council may make any amendment to the criteria and conditions contained in this resolution, whether by addition, deletion or amendment.
- 4) The Council may issue a resolution to stop or ban the printing, circulation or entry of the publication into the UAE if it violates the principles and standards of media content or if it does not obtain permission in accordance with the provisions of this resolution.
- 5) The Council may take the necessary measures to implement any resolution issued pursuant to the provisions of Clause (4) of this Article.





Article (15)

The Ministry of Education as well as the competent authorities shall be responsible for determining the age group of textbooks for the curricula.

Chapter VII Violations and penalties Article (16)

Without prejudice to any administrative procedure or any penalty stipulated under the relevant legislation, the Council may, in the event of a violation of the provisions hereof, impose any of the penalties stipulated under Resolution No. (__) of 2017 on the media content executive bylaw.

Grievance Article (17)

Any concerned party may submit a written grievance to the Director General against any resolution issued pursuant to the provisions of this resolution, in accordance with the conditions set forth in Resolution No. () of 2017 on the media content executive bylaw.

Article (18) Cancellations

Any provision that contradicts or conflicts with the provisions of this resolution shall be cancelled.





Article (19) Implementation of the resolution

The concerned authorities shall implement this resolution, each within its jurisdiction, and it shall come into force from the date of its issuance.
